

Dear Parent/Carer,

At the Engineering UTC we have a significant number of employer engagement activities planned for this academic year to inspire and motivate students. The students' start to Year 9 will include an Introduction to Industry and Higher Education day on Wednesday 4th of September which will be a day, off-timetable within the UTC. This will involve speaking to a number of people and organisations about the roles and opportunities available within the engineering sector and them getting involved in exciting activities linked to engineering.

The year 9 cohort were due to attend RAF Scampton on Thursday the 5th of September as part of their induction to the UTC where they were due to take part in different team building activities. Unfortunately due to unforeseen circumstances on Tuesday the 3rd of September, the RAF have had no alternative but to cancel this, due to security reasons. We have confirmed that an alternative trip to Scampton will definitely take place, however the date for this is to be confirmed.

At short notice, we have managed to secure an alternative trip to the Manchester Science and Industry museum. This is an interactive visit which will allow students to find out more about local industry and also includes an Aircraft exhibition. This will depart at 9.00am and will returned to the UTC for approximately 4.30pm.

Due to the change in plans, students will need to ensure that they bring along a packed lunch as dinner will not be provided. If any students are entitled to free school meals then they can collect a packed lunch from the canteen in the morning before the visit departs. The trip will now be school uniform, so all students will need to wear business dress.

Please note that all parents should have completed a "Student Detail" form which contains information about in case of emergency contacts and medical information. The forms were initially completed on the Parents Information evening in July 2019. All students will need to have returned a completed form on Wednesday in order to ensure that they can attend the trip on Thursday, in order to ensure that we have the correct emergency information for your child and consent for them to attend trips and visits. **This has been sent out with all students today and must be returned for the trip tomorrow.** If you have completed the form then please disregard this.
