

Dear Parent/Carer

I am writing to inform you of a forthcoming event scheduled for the 16th October.

Next Wednesday we are pleased to have the community Cohesion Officer from Humberside Police visit school to take students through a session on Hate Crime.

The term 'hate crime' can be used to describe a range of criminal behaviour where the perpetrator is motivated by hostility or demonstrates hostility towards the victim's disability, race, religion, sexual orientation or transgender identity.

A hate crime can include verbal abuse, intimidation, threats, harassment, assault and bullying, as well as damage to property.

The session is expected to take about an hour and students will be introduced to the way the law views and deals with Hate Crime in our community. It will also explore some of the issues surrounding Hate Crime and in particular the impact on victims that this kind of behaviour can have. These messages are necessary and can be quite hard-hitting but they will be delivered in a sensitive way and one which allows students to reflect on various situations and consider their own responses.
