### Update on opening for year 10 and 12 for some face to face time

I wrote to all year 10 and 12 parents on Friday to outline our plans to offer some face to face time with teachers from June 1<sup>st</sup>. This was in response to the Prime Ministers ambition and intention he laid out on May 10<sup>th</sup>.

If you managed to catch the Prime Ministers latest address on Sunday this has now been **delayed by two weeks** for secondary schools and he has asked schools to amend their plans and not to return any sooner.
